

Students who wish to register a language certificate

Students **who have a B2 or higher (CEFR scale) foreign language certificate not older than 3 years** on the day the course begins (i.e. not older than March 2023) listed in Appendix 2 to the AGH Senate Resolution no. 57/2019 of 24 April 2019, **may file a request to be exempt from the language course and the exam.** Their final grade is then based on the certificate grade. The final grade and the allocation of ECTS credits take place in the second semester of studies.

In order to register a certificate, you must:

1. Have a certificate recognized by SJO AGH ([list of certificates](#)) which does not date more than 3 years back (March 2023)
2. Download, print and fill in **the form** ([click here](#))
3. **Register all necessary documents** i.e. the printed declaration form and a photocopy of the certificate (the original copy must be presented at the time of registration) in the SJO office (building D-11, room 313 opening hours: 9:30-13:30) **immediately** on completion of the declaration form but not later than **13 February 2026**.
4. Your successful registration will be confirmed with **an email from the SJO office** informing you about the exemption from the language course.

We kindly remind you that if you are a student of:

- Faculty of Humanities (Fields: Cultural Studies, Sociology)
- Faculty of Geology, Geophysics and Environmental Protection (all Fields)
- New Technologies in Forensic Science (conducted by Faculty of Humanities, Faculty of Computer Science, Electronics and Telecommunications and Faculty of Material Science and Ceramics)

the regulations state that **the compulsory language of your course must be English, and you can register only an English language certificate.**

Students of other Faculties may register a certificate in any language as listed in Appendix 2 to the AGH Senate Resolution no. 57/2019 of 24 April 2019.

ENROL FOR OTHER LANGUAGE COURSES

After being exempt from the participation in the language classes and taking the exam, the students **may participate in a free foreign language course** within the limit of 135 teaching hours, without the obligation to pass an exam.

- **learn another foreign language**, on any level, including beginners
